

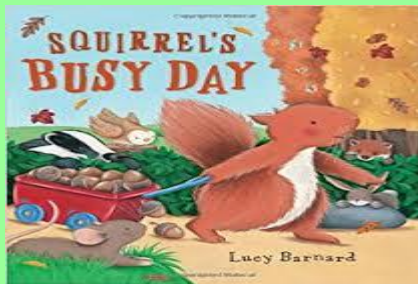

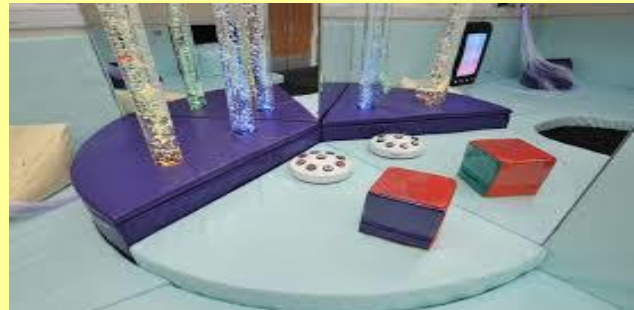


Welcome back!
