We hope you all had a lovely half term break. We are so excited to be back at school learning about autumn and look forward to starting our Christmas celebrations.

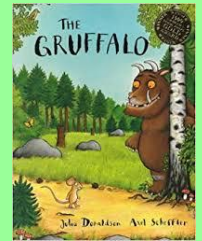
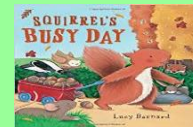
