Messy Play Activity of Week

Chocolate Baskets



You will need:

A mixing bowl, spoon, cupcake cases, 200g milk chocolate and 85g of cereal of your choice

Get an adult to melt 200g of milk chocolate, let it cool a bit then then add it to 85g of cereal with your child. Encourage them to mix the chocolate/cereal together and add the mixture to the cases (cornflakes, rice crispies, crushed Weetabix or shredded wheat).
