Weekly Story

Jasper's Beanstalk

Watch the story together and share these questions with your child

- Talk to the children and ask them what Jasper does each day of the week i.e. what does Jasper find on Monday? What does his do on Tuesday?
 - What does Jasper need to help grow his bean?
 - Role play the story together, pretending either one of you is Jasper.

Art activity of the week



Hand print Cherry Blossom tree. This is lovely fine motor activity. Draw around your child's hand/arm on brown paper then cut out and stick onto a piece of paper. Get them to apply the blossom with an earbud.

Number Beanstalk Activity



Draw 5 beanstalks on paper, start small for 1 then increase in size for 2, 3, 4 and 5. Get the children to build next to the beanstalks with blocks. Encourage them to count as they build their beanstalk with blocks and tell you how many they have once they've placed it down. Write the numerals underneath so the children can make the link.

2-3 cups of cornflour, food colouring (if you have any) and water.

This is a great motor skill activity. Use your hands or spoons to lift the mixture and watch as it turns to liquid and drips. Make this in a tray or mixing bowl.
