Weekly Story

Jasper's Beanstalk

- Talk to the children and ask them what Jasper does each day of the week i.e. what does Jasper find on Monday? What does he do on Tuesday?
 - What does Jasper need to help grow his bean?
- Role play the story together, pretending either one of you is Jasper.

Art activity of the week



Painting with cars. This is a really simple activity that can be done indoors or out on paper or cardboard. You could make a rainbow with the cars or do fun patterns with the wheels.

Number Activity



The above activity is fun, simple and easy to make. Get the children to match the numerals correctly and encourage them to identify them themselves. If your child can count to 10, make this activity 1-10.

The children enjoy practising the letter sounds to this video.

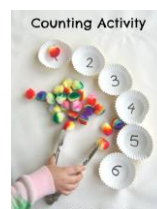

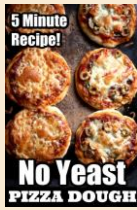
Number counting activity:

Sensory/Music

Shaving foam, paint or food colouring are a great combination together especially on tinfoil. Lay the tinfoil on a surface then apply the shaving foam, paint or food colouring and let the children explore. You could do general mark making patterns (circle, side-side, up down) to Wheels of the Bus or make smiley faces.
