## Mark Making – Dinner list

Why not encourage your child to take dinner orders for your family? Discuss what you'd all like for dinner/tea and get your child to make marks on paper to represent what you or your family have asked for on. You can scribe and write what their mark means. If you child can write their name, encourage them do so.

## Art activity of the week



Painting shapes. Draw a square, circle, rectangle and circle on paper. Use four different paint colours and get the children to paint each shape a different colour! Ask them to identify the shapes when they're finished.

## Number Activity

Feed and order the fish!! This activity is simple to make, draw and cut out 5 fish. If your child is working 1-10, then cut 10 out. Make sure you write the numerals on.

Activity 1: Order the fish. Encourage the children to sequence the fish in the correct order, 1-5 or 1-10.

Activity 2: Feed the fish! Using cereal or sweets, get the children to give the fish the correct amount of food.

Number song activity: 5 Little Fish

Using your fish, line them up 1-5 and sing this to the tune of 5 Little Ducks. 5 little fish went swimming one day, over the reef and far away, mummy fish went flap, flap, flap, flap and 4 little fish came swimming back.

I have attached the signs to use below.

Take a fish away each time one swims away! Enjoy!!

#### Messy Play Activity of Week

Chocolate Mug cake!



This is a great way to make a little cake with the children without having to use too many ingredients. Get them to help you measure the ingredients out and mix them together. This is great activity for following instructions and fine motor skills.

You will need: 35g plain flour, 2 tablespoons cocoa powder/drinking chocolate, 2 tablespoons granulated sugar, pinch of salt, 60 grams of milk, 2 tablespoons vegetable oil, 1 tablespoon chocolate spread/chocolate chips or chopped chocolate

1. Mix the dry ingredients in a large mug

- 2. Mix the wet ingredients in until there are no lumps
- 3. Put the chocolate spread, chocolate chips or chopped chocolate into the middle
- 4. Get an adult to put it in the microwave for 70 seconds. Let it cool before the children taste it.
