Your challenge is to guess which story I am going to read to you.


Think of all the stories you know and write them all down in a list. I would love to see your writing and you will be able to send it to me too!




Think about: What shape is a window? What shape is on the end of a tin of beans?


Now, go on a shape hunt and look for 2d shapes. Try and find 2 of each.

I went on a shape hunt in my garden and I found :


My List
