

This week's story is 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'




I am going to send you a video of me reading the story from my home.

Think about what happens at the beginning and the end of the story.


Art Activity of the Week

I am going to make a video of the story and send it to you. I hope you will send me things too and we can continue to learn together.


