Weekly Story

This week I would like you to read your favourite story together and draw me a picture of your favourite part or character. You can help draw the picture and encourage your child to colour the picture in.



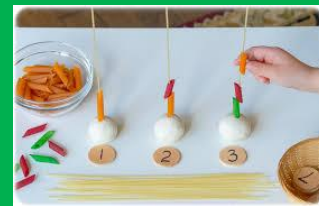
Mark Making – your picture



Use the picture you've drawn and coloured together, ask your child what or who they can see. What is the character wearing? What colours can they see? Are there any animals in your picture? If so, what type and can you sign the animal(s) together? Encourage your child to mark make their answers next to their picture (you can write, next to it, what they've told you and said they're writing). Don't forget, please take a photo so you can share their work on Evidence for Learning.



Number Activity



Spaghetti threading!

This activity is simple to do. You will need 5 pieces of spaghetti if your child is working 1-5, and 10 if they're working 1-10. Or you could use 1 and ask them to thread a specific number of pasta pieces on. Write your numerals on paper.

Activity 1: Using either playdough, blue tack or oranges, stick the spaghetti in. Show the children a number and get them to thread the correct amount of pasta/cereal pieces on.

Activity 2: Order either 5 or 10 pieces of spaghetti and place the paper with the numerals written on in front of the spaghetti in the correct order. Get the children to thread the correct amount/cereal pieces on.

Art activity of the week



Make a flying saucer together to use when doing this week's number song. Use resources that you have at home. Here's an example of items you could use: a paper plate, cardboard cut circular, paper, tissue paper, paint, sequins/glitters, pom-poms, cupcake cases, tin foil. Look at the example above to give you your saucer together!

Messy Play Activity of the Week

Cakes!



You will need: cake cases, a muffin tray. See below for a list of food items you use if you don't have flour

This activity is great for promoting a range of skills. You could role play being in a café, pretend that you're having a tea party or do some maths and get your child to fill a specific amount of cases (for example 1-5).

You could also pretend to be making 5 currant buns and sing the song. I know that flour is difficult to source at present, but don't worry, use anything that you have at home that works as a substitute. You could use sand, cocoa powder, soil, rice, pasta or playdough and pretend that it's cake mixture. If you don't have any candles, don't worry, you could make some out of cardboard if you have some.
