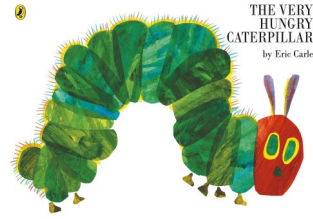

Make shapes to make a butterfly and use cocktail sticks or a pencil to make patterns. Try and make each wing look the same.

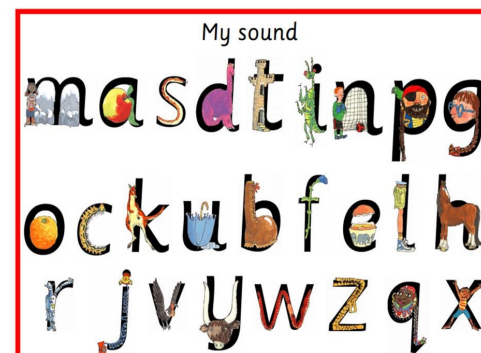

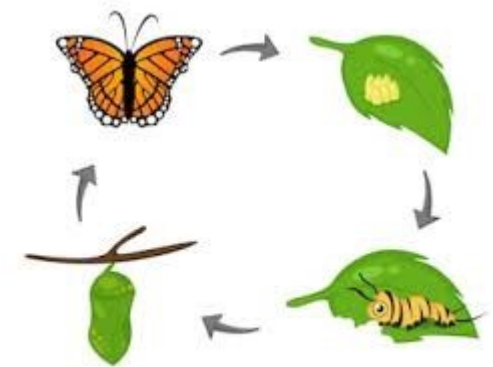

Think about how a caterpillar grows and then transforms into a butterfly.

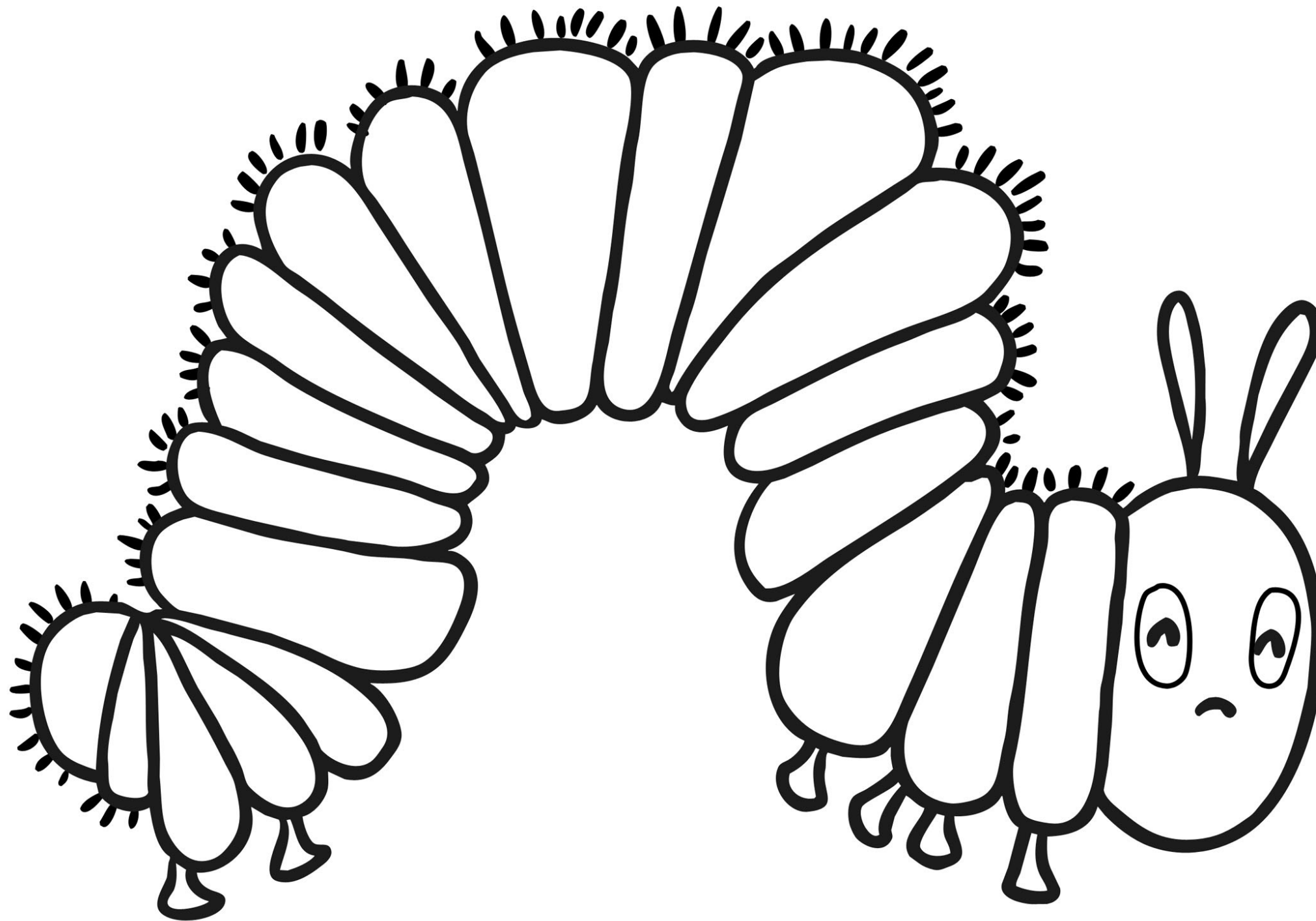
