- Listen to the story again this week
- What can you see? Do some labelling/mark making. Draw your child a fish on paper, colour it in then get them to label/mark make what they can see. Ask them these questions; what can you see? A fish. What colour is it? What is its name? Show me where its eye is.

Art activity of the week – Underwater collage:



You will need:

- Egg box
- Blue paint
- Fish drawn on paper, coloured in and cut out
- Shells (if you have any)
- Glue
- Glitter
- Sequins

I hope you enjoy making this underwater fish scene. If the weather picks up, why not take a little trip to the beach to collect some shells? Please stay safe on your trip.

Maths activity 1:

Counting:



Feed the shark: You will need: a cardboard tube, make a shark head like above and stick it on. Write numerals on paper. Show you child a specific numeral and ask them to feed the shark that quantity. You could either make little fish to feed to the shark or use cereal. This is great for the development of fine motor skills.



Maths activity 2:

- Size ordering/sorting. Can child sort the fish into big/small categories? Can they sequence and order by size (smallest to largest)?

Size Ordering/Sorting: Please don't worry if you don't have a printer to print these, you can easily hand draw them. Activity 1: create two separate pile Big/Little and get your child to sort the big/little underwater creatures first. Activity 2: get your child to sequence the underwater creates by their size starting from smallest to biggest.
