- We love this story and love to act out the characters
- So, can you flap like the duck, wiggle like the pig and stamp like the sheep?
- How about creating a sensory story? Gather plastic animals to match those in the story and fill a bucket with a little bit of water. Watch the story together and imitate the text and animal's moves. Encourage your child to join in with key phrases such as 'frog cried wheeeee! Can you dance like me? Down by the cool of the pool' Then at the end of the story, get all of the animals to jump into the pool!!



## Art activity of the week -Frog:



- You will need:
- Green paper – make the legs and body
  - White and black paper for the eyes
  - Yellow paper – make the spots
  - A sharpie or permanent marker for the mouth

I hope you enjoy making this frog together. You can use it in your sensory story but don't get him wet!!

## Messy Play and mark making activity of the week

### Fairy soup



This is a lovely activity. All you need are flowers and foliage from your garden, pans, glitter, and ladles, mixing spoons, tea spoons, cups/bowls and jugs. It is great for pretend play. You could pretend to make a soup for the fairies, dollies or teddies then host a little tea party whereby your child has to ladle the soup into bowls and serve it to their guests. You could also run this as a little café and get the whole family involved! The role play opportunities are endless! Have fun!
