

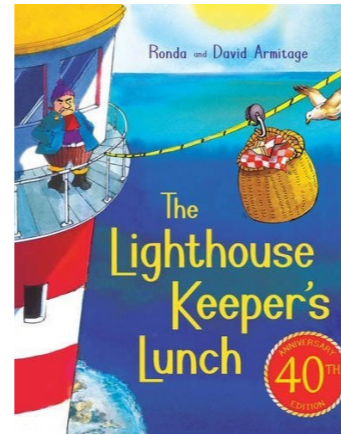
## English

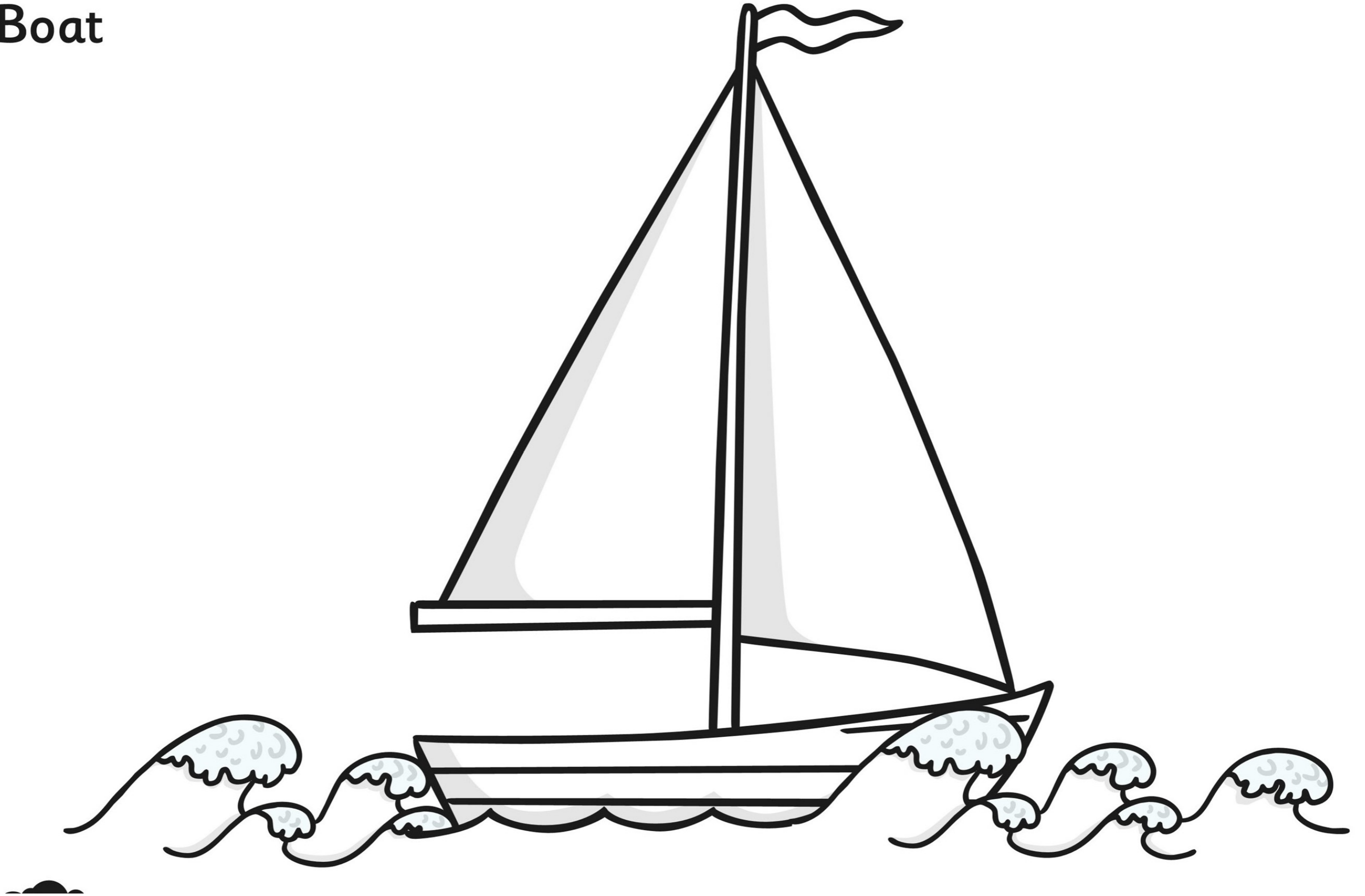
