Hello and welcome back. It is lovely to see all the children settling back into school and into their new class daily routines.

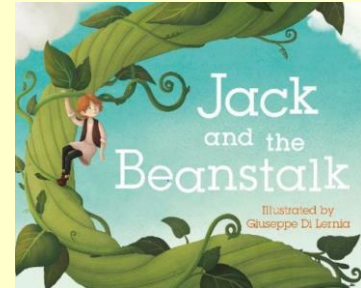
We will spend the next few weeks getting to know our environment, getting to know each other and making new friends.
