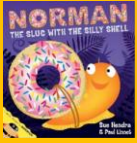




## Key Stage 2 Newsletter – Summer Term 2023

#### Our Curriculum this term:

##### Science:

Now that spring is upon us, what better time to be taking a look at the gorgeous flowers and plants that bloom around this time of year. We will be looking at identifying the features of plants and flowers and trying to grow our own.



##### Art

In art we will be revisiting seasons of the year, looking at the colours that you see during the seasons and using pastel chalks to create our own season themed artwork.



##### Computing

The children will be looking at robots and how to input instructions to create an algorithm. They will also be accessing the programming platform Scratch to engage in different elements of programming and identify ways to 'debug' the programming if the icon moves in the wrong direction.

Our PE day is on Monday afternoon.

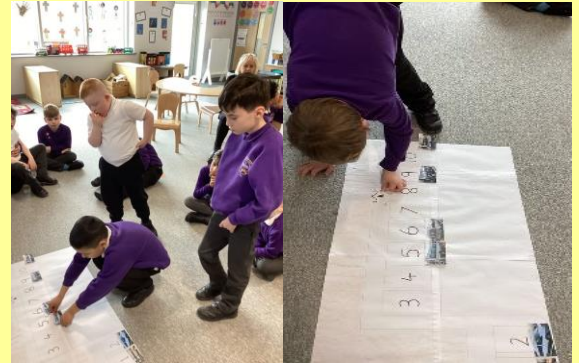
This term we will be focusing on kicking, running and changing directions. We will also be continuing to have MFC coming in for 3 sessions throughout this half term.



#### Some of the things we have learnt so far

##### Geography:

We have been learning that signs, plans and symbols can help us find our way around places. We looked at different plans including the one of our school. The children made a plan to identify the school entrance and the bays where their own bus stops.



##### Art:

We have been learning about the sculptures of Anthony Gormley such as the Angel of the North. The children have learnt that sculptures can be made from different materials. They enjoyed making their own sculptures using different natural materials.
