Literacy

Our text this term is **The Tiger who came to tea**, a familiar and enjoyable story. The children will continue to work hard in learning new phrases and words, focus on motor skill in writing and mark making & sensory exploration



DT

The children will be learning how we can make moving figures using split pins. They will learn that we can use different resources and simple tools in a safe way can make things move.

Maths

The children will continue to develop mathematical skills. We will focus on number skills, counting objects to 10 and beyond with a focus on quantity representation & will continue to use songs and rhymes. We will explore shapes using shapes to build, learn 3D shape names and recognise common features of shapes.



Art

The children will explore colour, learning how mixing 2 colours together can make 1 new colour.

History

This term we will learn about vehicles & compare common features, we will look at how they travel and move. We will then look at past and present to see how vehicles have developed over time.

Science

In science we will be focusing on the human body, we will be comparing hair & eye colour & drawing self-portraits. We will then look at animals and compare humans and animals, for example counting legs and body hair such as fur and skin.
