Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: **Jungle Animals**

Some rhymes we will be learning: 10 Green Bottles, 10 fat sausages, 5 little speckled frogs

This term we will be participating in a range of Speech and Language sessions including Stop! Elephant, Stop! and Rumble in the Jungle. This will help us develop our listening and engagement, as well as helping to promote spontaneous language and participation in a group setting.

In English, we will be learning to trace over discrete patterns and copy marks made by adults. We will be improving our cutting and fine motor skills and we will be acting out parts of our stories using jungle animal movements and noises.

In Maths, we will be exploring 2D shapes and how they fit together. We will be exploring repeating patterns and practising rote counting up to 10 through number rhymes and number activities.
