- To begin to help tidy up and return items to where they belong

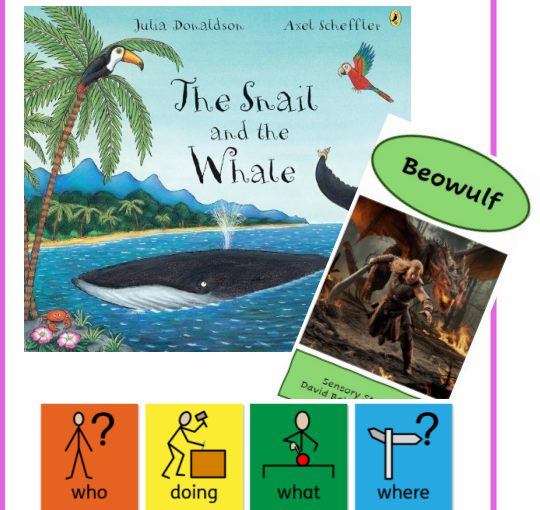
Curriculum: We are learning...
