**Curriculum: We are learning...**

Our topic this term is: **People that help us.**

Some rhymes we will be learning are: 10 Green Bottles, 10 fat sausages, 10 in the bed and Alice the camel

In English, we are building on communication and language whilst predicting familiar text in stories and introducing role play /responding to parts of a familiar story. We will be exploring the value of kindness and people who help us in the community

Each day we will have SALT (speech and language) sessions, and we' will be enjoying various interventions during which we will focus on social interaction, language development, and confidence-building activities.

In Maths, we are learning how to sort objects according to two or more criterion (e.g. colour, shape, size) and rote count beyond 10. We are also beginning to match number to quantity.
