This half term we will be working with the children to:

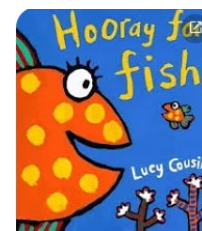
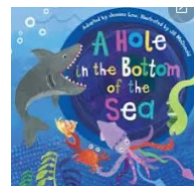
- Learn our routines

### Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: **Under the sea**

We will be using these texts:

**Hole at the bottom of the sea, Shark in the Park, Hooray for fish and Busy Beach.**



We will be learning the rhymes: 5 little Penguins, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 one I caught a fish, 10 green bottles and The ants came marching 1 by 1.

In English we will be looking at predicting repetitive texts. During Maths we will be exploring 2d shapes and looking at shape patterns.

We will set activities that encourage the children to develop hygiene routines. We will work with the children to develop their communication skills through Speech and Language activities and build up their tolerance to different experiences and learn through a sensory approach.
