Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: **Space and planets**

Some rhymes we will be learning are: 10 Green Bottles, The Ants Came Marching 1 by 1, 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive

In English, we will be developing our fine motor skills through threading activities, mark making using a stipple technique within a defined area and using tweezers to pick items up. We will act out parts of our stories and develop our interest in books.

In Maths, we will be learning to sequence up to 3 familiar events, we will be learning to add one to a given number and we will be focusing on one more and one less. We will also be looking at repeated patterns and using our fine motor skills to follow the pattern.

Our Speech and Language activities will be Twinkle, twinkle little star (singing and signing), It's a blast and Mr Gumpy's boat
