Wider Curriculum: We are learning...

Science—We will learn what plants are safe to eat and be able to name and label some of these, we will grow a plant, eg a bean and observe changes

Geography—Exploring human and physical features in different locations, we will visit a park, Middlesbrough sports village and Natures World.

Art—Pupil will learn what warm colours are, they will use different objects to make prints, such as fruits and vegetables. This will link with our Science and DT as we explore and grow fruit and vegetables and enjoy tasting them.

Maths

In maths we will continue to develop our counting skills, counting to 30 and beyond. We will learn what more and less means and be able to identify groups of objects where the difference is significant using signs and symbols.

We will continue to use rhymes to encourage counting and learning the sequencing of numbers. Through modelling the children will begin to use their fingers to count.
