This term we will be working with the children to:

- Communicate using signs/ symbols/verbally
- Observe and identify different weather conditions
- Develop physical skills by exploring going under, over and through.
- Develop careful listening skills
- Identify various forest sounds

Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: **Forest**

Some rhymes we will be learning: 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive, 10 green bottles, the ants came marching 1 by 1, 5 monkeys on the bed, 5 speckled frogs and the animals went in 2 by 2.

In Maths we will be exploring number and counting through sensory play and through number songs and rhymes. Singing the rhymes above at home will help your child recognise numbers and practise their joint interaction with you. In class we are also focusing on counting out objects up to 10 and early addition skills by adding one more and adding two amounts together to count the total.

In English we will be exploring different stories linked to our topic of forest, singing nursery rhymes and exploring initial sounds and sounds in our environment.

Our daily SALT sessions will focus on developing social interactions, attention and language development and some of the activities this term include 'Rumble in the Jungle' and BLAST.
