Our focus is on Team games and Athletics.

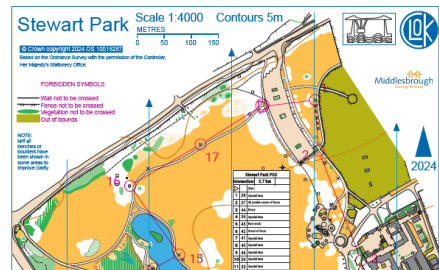

Our themes for this term:

Physical development: - The better weather will allow us to engage in more sporting experiences outside of the academy including orienteering in local parks. Pupils also continue to access many opportunities across the school during the school day including lunch clubs. We will be celebrating the Paralympics and The World Cup among other things.

Social and Cultural studies—A combination of History, Geography and RE is focused on within this lesson, we are exploring Landscapes and how these have changed over millions of years. We will be looking at maps and rivers, exploring how humans and natural processes have changed landscapes.
