This term we will be working with the children to:

- Increase their independence in the classroom
- Develop focus and attention for extended tasks
- Learn team sports
- Develop problem-solving skills

## Curriculum: We are learning...

In English: Narrative writing using the text 'Augustus and his Smile', and explanation text writing relating to plants and using the text 'The Great Kapok Tree.'

In Maths: Focusing on our individual number, space and measure targets. We will be learning to apply our number skills to maths across the curriculum.

In History: We will look at the history of our monarchy and explore why it is important.

In Geography: We will look at mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes.

In RE: We will question 'Where do we get our values?'

In Music: We will be exploring tuned instruments and following notation.

In PE: We are exploring team games and outdoor activities.

In Computing: We will be building on researching the internet and storing information.

In Art: We are exploring photography and also tie-dye and printing on fabric.

In Science: We will explore the function of the main parts of a plant, and how water transportation takes place.
